Dear Parents,

One of the things that makes Bournebrook so special is our size. Having just twenty children in each year group means that all staff know all of the children in school and I, as headteacher, don't just get to know their names, but also lots about them. From the children's point of view it means that they will have friends of all ages, as children from Reception to Year Six play alongside each other on the playground. This helps to develop the caring and friendly ethos of the school.

Being a small school means that children work in mixed-age classes. Teachers are used to this and adept at delivering the correct curriculum to all children, at a pace that best facilitates learning and good progress. When parents send their children to Bournebrook, they are, in effect, accepting this and therefore need to trust the school to make the right decision for their child when it comes to which class they are in.

Classes are organised as follows:

Nursery (Rainbow)	Cherry	Elm	Willow	Beech	Ash
Nursery aged children	Reception aged children	All Year One children and half of Year Two children	Half of Year Two children and all of Year Three children	All of Year Four children and half of Year Five children	Half of Year Five children and all of Year Six children

From this, it can be seen that year two and year five children are split. We make this split based on academic achievement and the decision is made by the headteacher, in consultation with staff and governors. *Parents can rest assured that whichever class their child is in, they will receive the curriculum for their year group, delivered at an appropriate pace.* Classes may do work at different times or on different days, but all work for the year group will be covered. It is in our interest, as well as parents, that children in all classes progress well and achieve highly.

Parents will find out which class their child is in approximately a week before class transfer day, in order that they may prepare children at home for this. We ask that parents trust us to make the correct decision on classes for their child; we know where your child will make best progress. Decisions will not be changed based on parental requests or complaints.
