We are reminded of the potential dangers of the internet through the very sad, and increasingly common, stories on the news. Primary school children do not have the emotional maturity to handle the complex social interactions on social media and I urge parents to carefully monitor children's internet usage and close down any accounts which children are not legally old enough to have.

Please also remind children that should they receive any message online that gives them "Early Warning Signs" they should exit the game or account and tell an adult immediately.
