
Sing the days of the week song to find out. What day was it yesterday? What day will it be tomorrow? Can you say it in a sentence... Today it is...

Top of the Beanstalk Writing Activity

What happens in the story? What happens to Jasper's bean?

What does Jasper do? Why does Jasper dig up his bean?

Ask the children what they think might be at the top of Jasper's Beanstalk if it grew so tall it reached the clouds! What might be at the top? In your book draw a picture of what you think would be at the top of Jasper's Beanstalk. Ask your child to tell you what they have drawn. Now they can write a sentence about their picture.

Write the ay and ai words on a piece of paper and ask the children to sort the words into ay and ai words. The children copy the words into their books making two lists. **pay, pain, day, train, hay, sail, tray, mail, say** Can they think of any more?

Creative

Natural Art Beanstalks

Go outside in your garden, you are going to make a beanstalk picture. What could you use to make a beanstalk? How could you make the leaves? What could you use for the stalk? Things you could use-Pebbles, stones, petals, grass, twigs, sticks

Encourage your child to collect materials they would like to use to create their beanstalk picture. Encourage them to gather their materials and start arranging them to create their picture.

Support your child to lay their materials onto the ground. Encourage them to begin by creating the stalk of their beanstalk. Talk about what they might like to use e.g. twigs and sticks. Then encourage them to add some leaves to their beanstalk picture. Encourage your child to talk about the textures, shapes and colours of the materials they are using and what they need to look for next.
