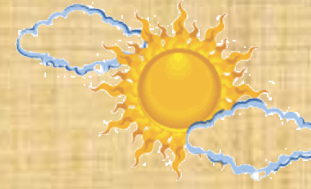

## Addition word problems

Jasper has got 6 beans in his bag, he finds 2 more. How many has he got altogether?

Jack's hen laid 5 eggs on Monday and 3 on Tuesday. How many eggs has he got altogether?

The Giant had 7 gold coins in his hand and 3 in his pocket. How many has he got altogether?

Jasper has 4 bananas and Jack has 4. How many bananas are there altogether?

Jack's hen laid 7 eggs on Thursday and 5 on Friday. How many eggs has he got altogether?

Jasper finds 6 snails on the beanstalk and 5 on the ground. How many snails are there altogether?

The children can draw the beans and count to find the total.



They can use counters or write the number sentences.

$$6+2=$$
