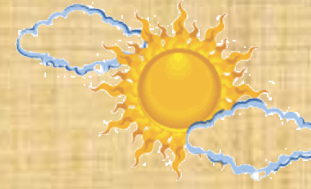

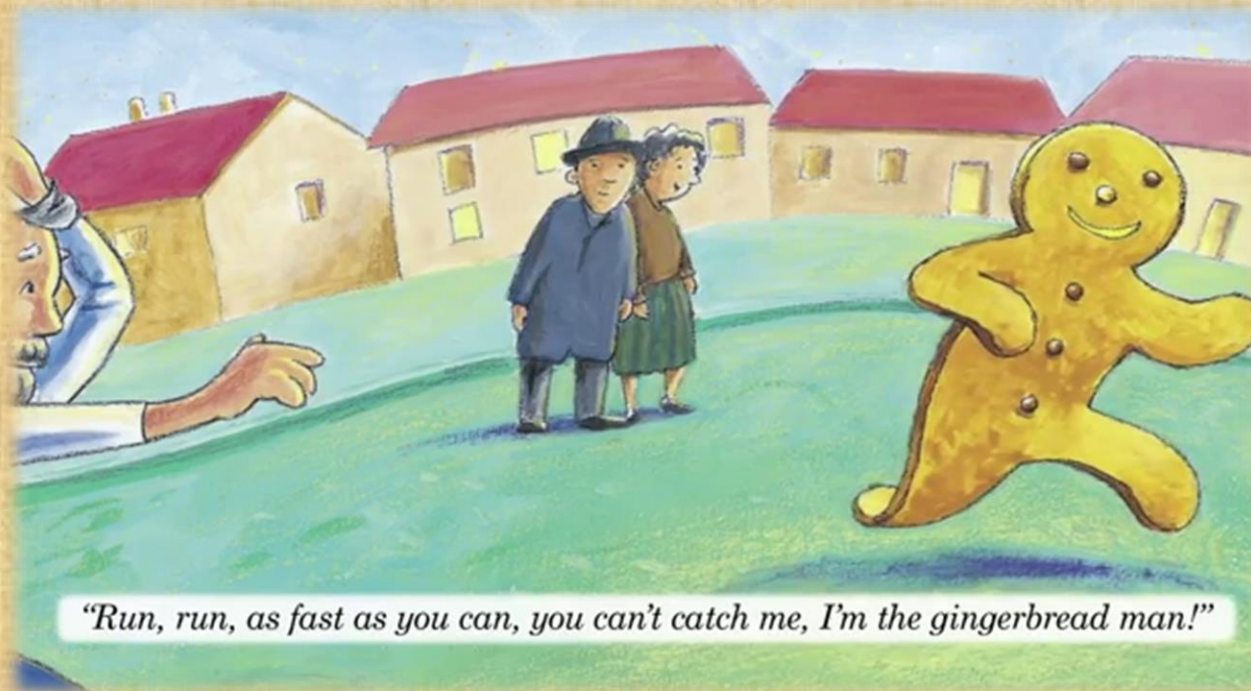

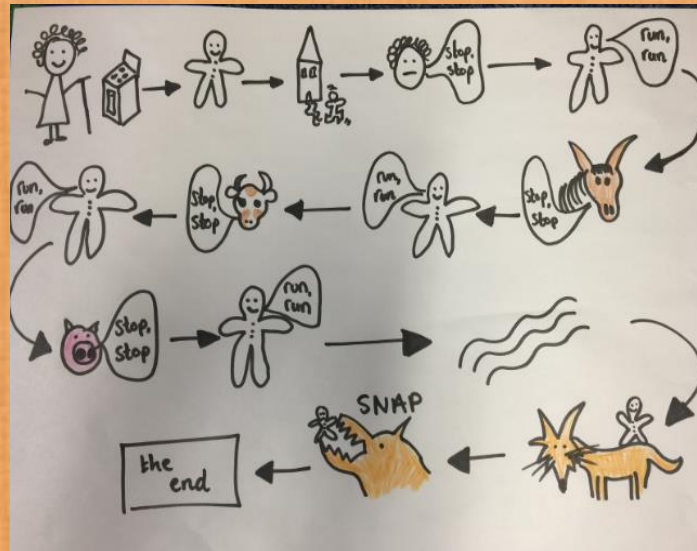
Listen to the story! Encourage your child to join in with the repeated parts of the story and talk about the story events.

Talk to your child about the order of events in the story.

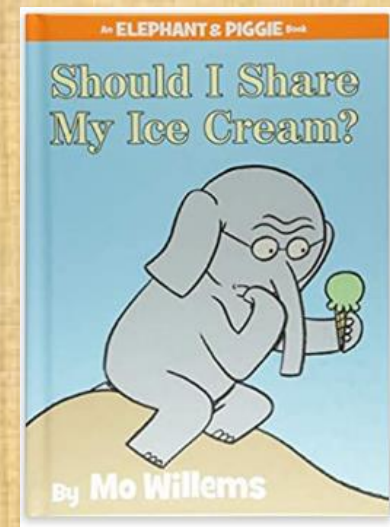


Ask your child to draw a story map in their book.

A dice

Pom poms or small paper circles

2 ice cream cones drawn on a piece of paper

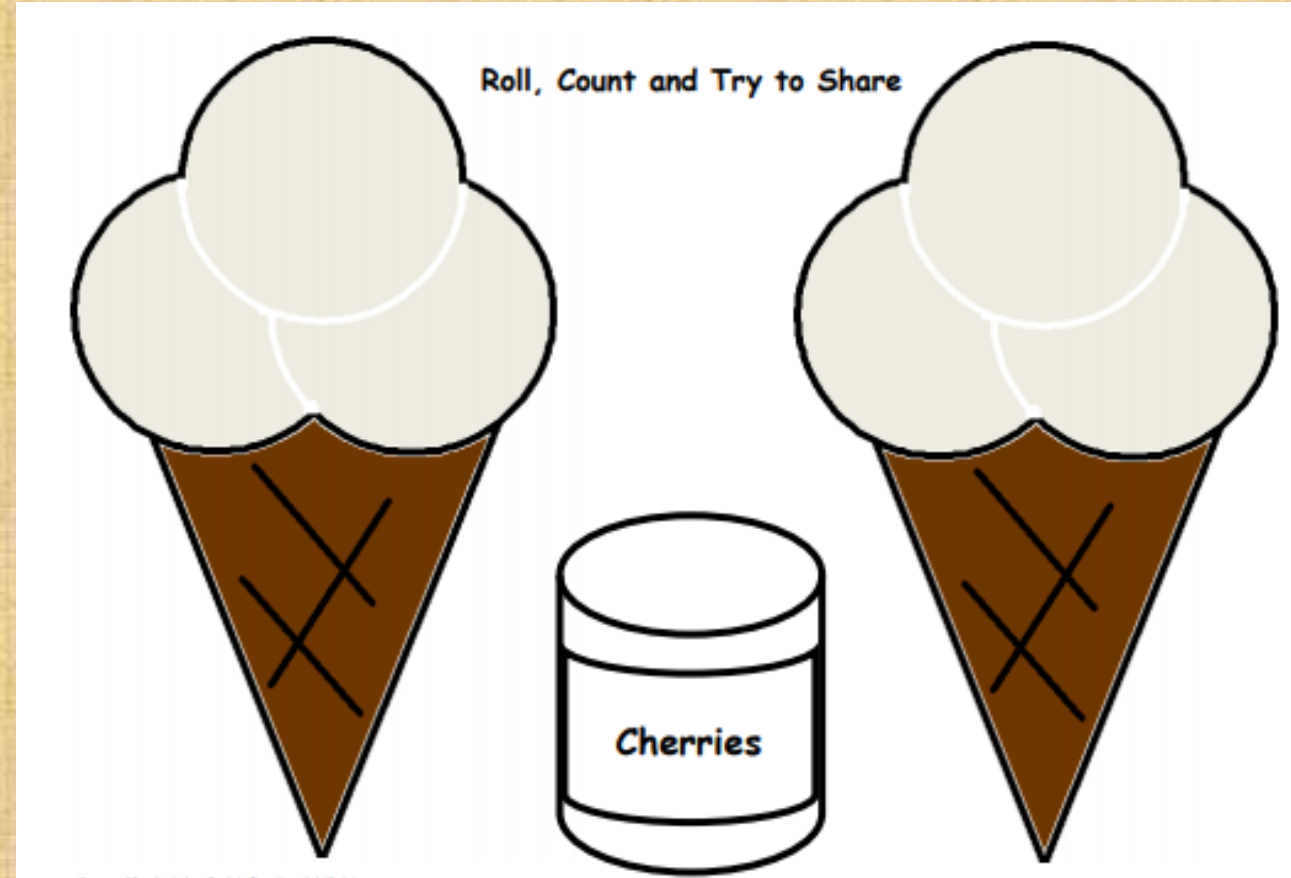
Maths

Explain to your child that they are going to roll the die.

Then they are going to gather up the number of pom-poms/paper circles that matches that number.

Next they are going to try and share the pom-poms with each ice cream cone equally.

If they can't, they will roll again.
