

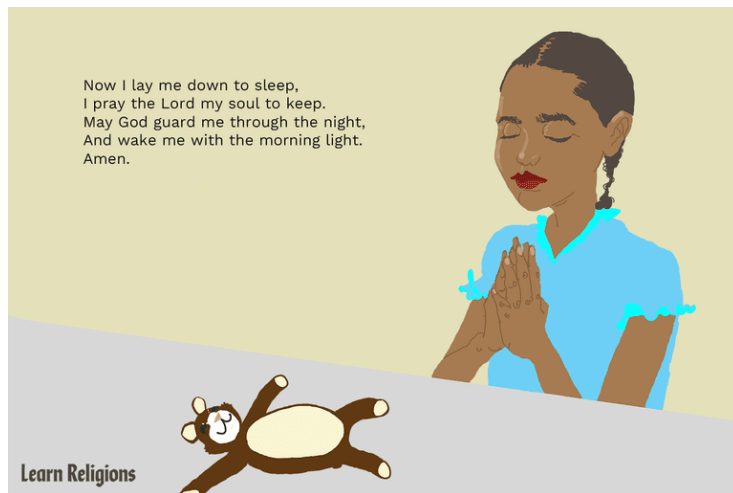

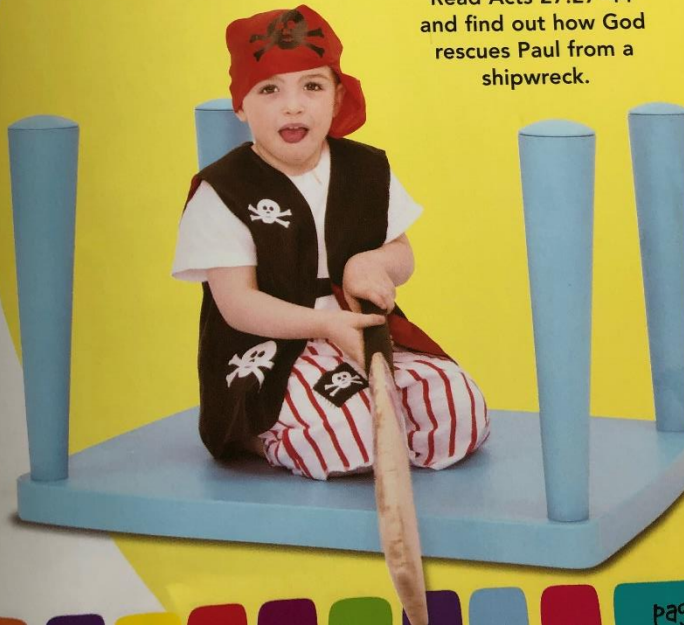
A ship at sea
