





Examples

Nico and Karen read books in the ratio of 5:1. If they read 42 books in total, how many does Nico read?

There are 5 + 1 = 6 shares in total. 1 share = 42 + 6 = 7 books Nico reads 5 shares, so he reads 5 × 7 = 35 books



For every 2 paintings that Michelle finishes, Deirdre finishes 3. They finish 75 paintings in total. How many paintings does each artist finish?












Deirdre finishes 3



There are 2 + 3 = 5 shares in total.

1 share = $75 \div 5 = 15$ paintings.

Michelle has 2 shares, so does 2 × 15 = 30 paintings.

Deirdre has 3 shares, so does $3 \times 15 = 45$ paintings.
