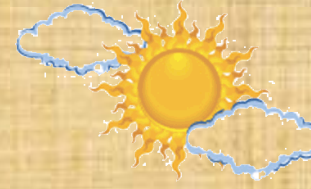

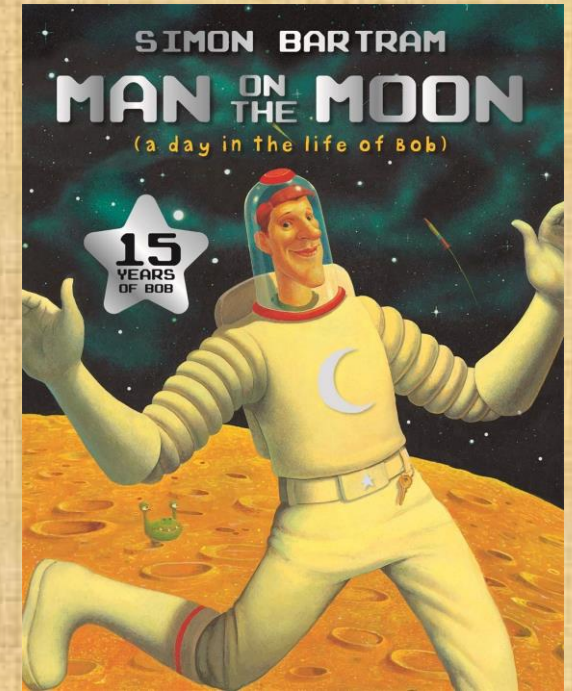

We are meeting Bob today

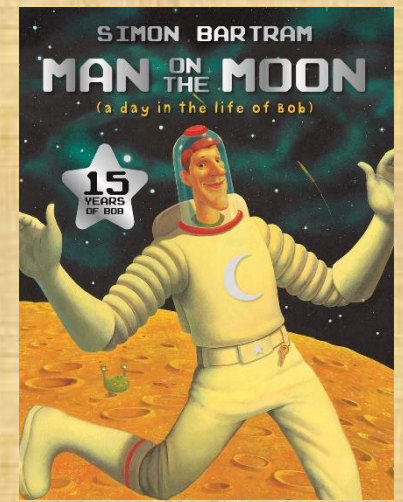

Can you write a list of things Bob will need to take to the moon. Remember to write each new word on a separate line.

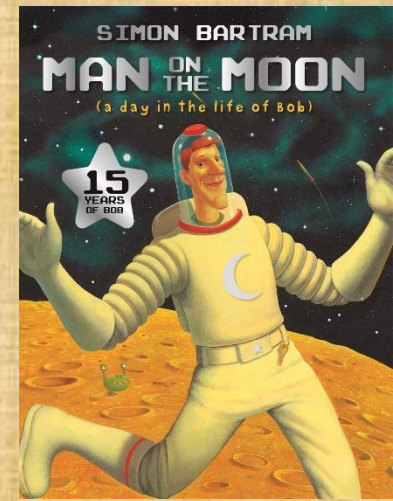

Maths

Our focus today is counting back.



**Today's Number
is 2**

Show them number 2. Can they tell you the number? What is 1 more than 2? What is 1 less than 2?

We need to help Bob blast off into space. For his rocket to blast off we need to count back from 20 to 0.

Lets practise counting back from 10-1 first.

Children to count down

10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1

Draw some numbers in order outside in your garden using chalk or make some number cards 0-20. Lay them out in order. Now start on 20 and count back to 0 by saying each number name as you jump on each number.

You can practise writing your numbers in your maths book.

Click on parents, interactive resources, phase 3, Flash cards speed trial and finally phases 2 and 3. The children then say the sound that comes up on the screen. This activity needs to be done everyday.
