Say your observations in a sentence:

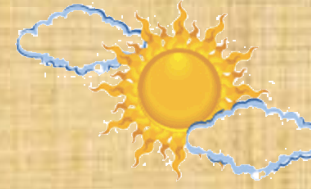

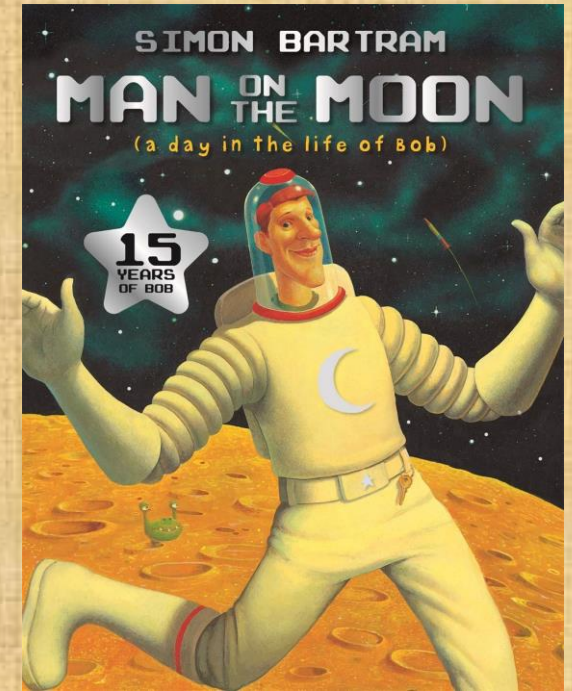

## Man on the Moon (a day in the life of Bob)

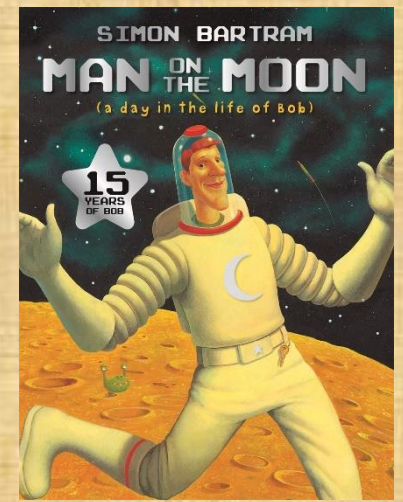

# Literacy

## Writing sentences to describe Bob



We are going to write some sentences describing Bob.

Ask your child what think Bob is like. Show them the video clip from Monday or look through the pictures of the book. They can describe what he looks like and what they think his personality is like.

Ask these questions to help:

Is Bob kind?

Is he helpful?

Do you think Bob is friendly?

Is Bob tall?

Does Bob like animals?

When your child answers the questions turn their answers into a sentence eg Bob is kind and helpful.

Write some sentences using finger spaces of to describe Bob.



# Maths

Our focus today is adding

**Today's Number  
is 19**

Show them number 19. Can they tell you the number? What is 1 more than 19? What is 1 less than 19?

Today we are going to use our addition skills to tell number stories.

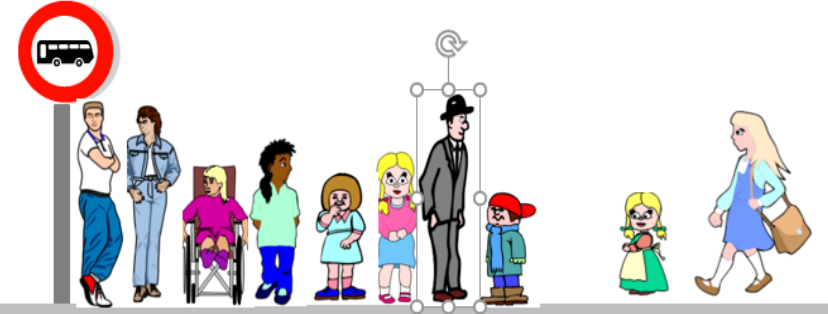
Remember when we add things together the number gets bigger.

Say the above bus number story to your child.

8 people are waiting for the bus.

2 more join the queue at the bus stop.

How many people are waiting for the bus?



$$8 + 2 =$$

Show your child the picture of the people waiting for the bus and the number sentence underneath. Say 8 add 2 equals- then ask your child how they can work out the answer. They should say by counting all the people.

Answer the following number stories in your maths book.

4 passengers are on the bus.  
2 more passengers get on.  
How many are on the bus altogether?

5 buns on the plate.  
I get 2 more buns  
How many buns are there altogether?

There are 5 hot air balloons in a race.  
3 more balloons join.  
How many balloons are there altogether?



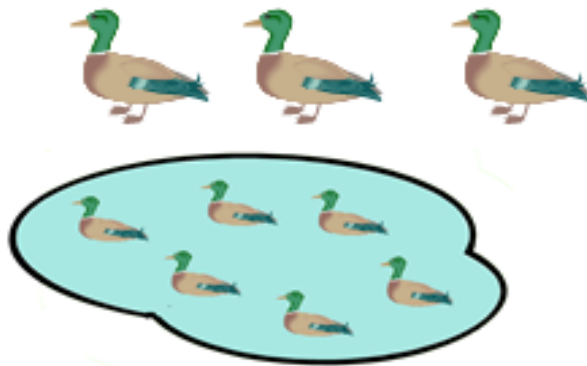

How many presents do I have altogether?



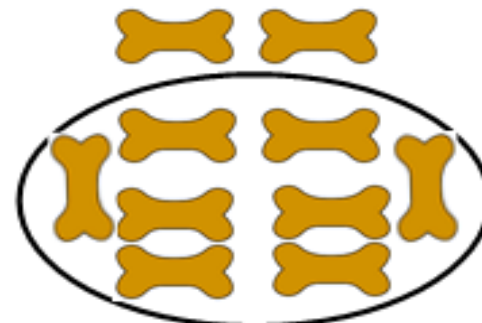
