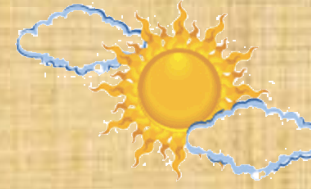

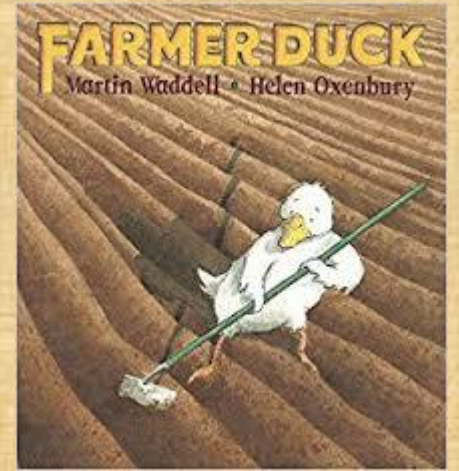

Today's story is Farmer Duck by Martin Waddell

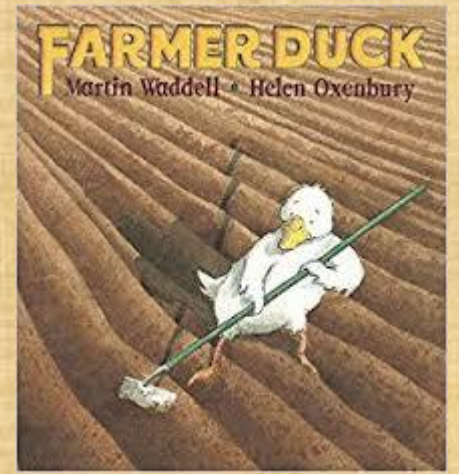

Literacy

Writing sentences



Talk about the story with your child. Where is the story set? Who is/are the main characters? Ask your child to describe these characters – their personalities (Farmer was lazy and bossy. The duck was hard working & kind). Why was Duck so sad and miserable?

Choose either the duck or the farmer to write some sentences to describe them.

E.g.

The farmer was mean and lazy.

The duck was busy and tried hard.

Remember to say the sentences first and then write them. Think about the sounds you can hear and use finger spaces.

Maths

Our focus today is halving.



**Today's Number
is 14**

Show them number 14. Can they tell you the number? What is 1 more than 14? What is 1 less than 14?

We have been looking at sharing and we know that when we share things out, we need to each have the same. If I half something what happens? Listen to the story

In reception children only need to be introduced to the concept of halving practically. Ask your child 'what can we half?'
Have a go at halving some things:
Cake
Shapes by cutting them in half.
An Easter egg (if you have got any left!)
Pizza
The play fruit and vegetables that are velcroed together are really good to teach halving.
