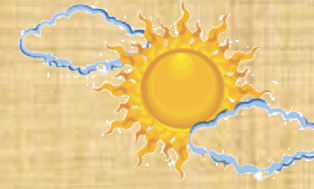

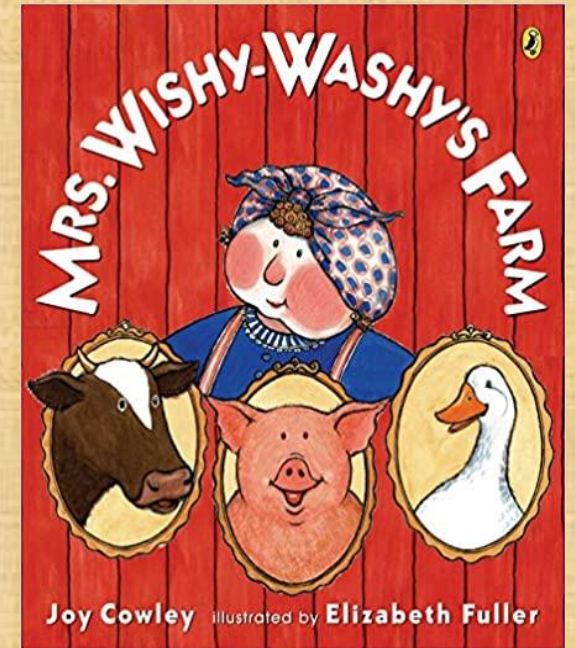

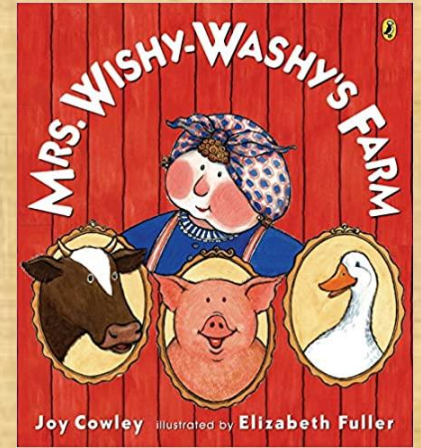

You are going to write another page for the story. Before the animals get taken to the animal jail they are going to visit another 'barn' (shop). Think of another shop the animals could visit.

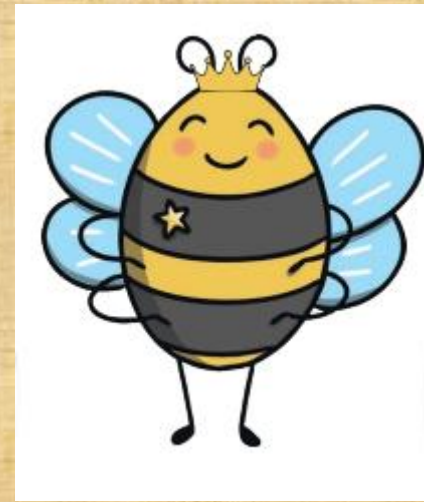
Next the animals go into a shoe shop, toy shop, bakery

Our focus today is halving



**Today's Number
is 4**

Show them number 4. Can they tell you the number? What is 1 more than 4? What is 1 less than 4?

Have different lengths of string or paper.

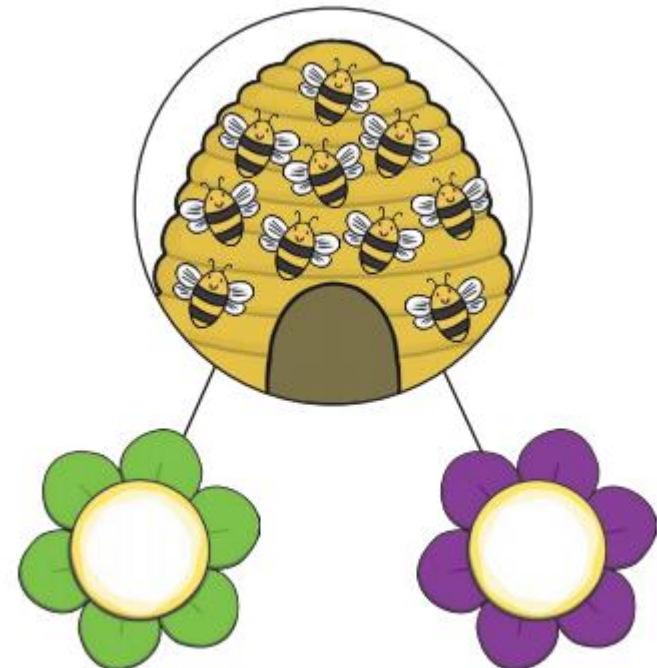
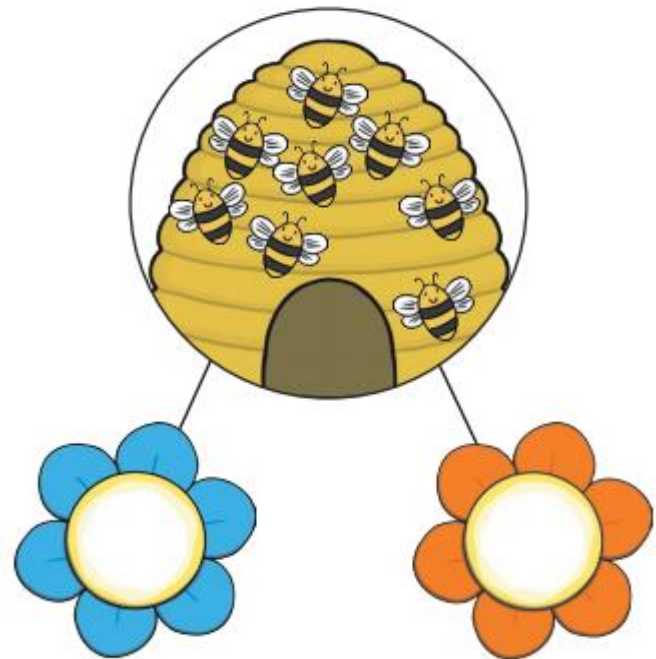
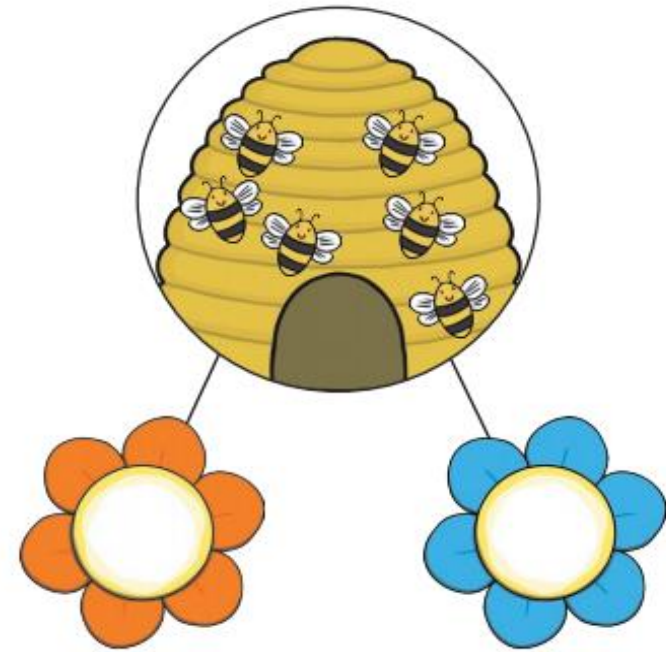
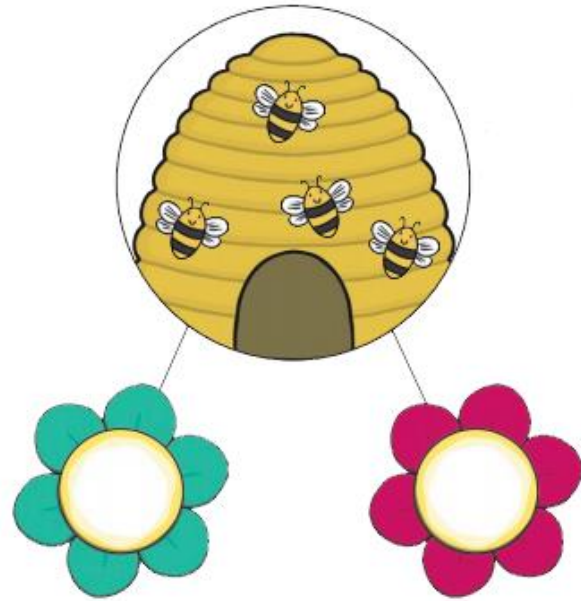
Show your child the whole piece and then cut into half. Ask your child if it has been cut in half?

Repeat with new lengths of string or paper sometimes cutting in half and sometimes not. Let your child check the two pieces to see if they have been cut in half.

The queen bee needs to share the bees out fairly so that each flower has half the number of bees from the hive. Can you help the queen bee put half of the bees on to each flower? (on the next page)

Draw the flowers and then draw the bees on the flowers.
