

For example -

The huge, silver tail flaps powerfully when moving the house through the water.

A neat, joined handwriting style.



**What to do:**

- All the recipes will last if kept in the fridge and you can even eat the fruit afterwards!


Got some of your fancy

 ginger


**Strawberry, Basil & Lemon**

5 cups of Tap Water  
 1 cup of ice cubes  
 1/2 cup of strawberries  
 5 torn basil leaves  
 1 lemon thinly sliced

**Blueberry, Lemon & Rosemary**

5 cups of Tap Water  
 1 cup of ice cubes  
 1/2 pint of blueberries  
 1 lemon thinly sliced  
 4 sprigs of fresh rosemary

**Watermelon, Kiwi & Lime**

5 cups of Tap Water  
 1 cup of ice cubes  
 1/2 cup of watermelon in cubes  
 1 lime thinly sliced  
 1 cup coconut chunks

You could serve your fancy drink to your family as part of any VE Day Celebrations that you might be having.




