## KEEPING YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION SAFE

- ◆ Never show your school uniform on YouTube because anyone can see it.
- ◆ Don't share or leave any personal information in view, like your parents' bank details.
- ◆ Make sure not to show your face. If you don't feel comfortable with strangers seeing it, blur it out.
- ◆ Remember not to show or reveal your school or any of your family's address - it's dangerous.

Don't share any personal information! Strangers can hack into your accounts or may find out how to come and see you.



## PASSWORDS + SETTINGS

When creating a YouTube account it is important to think about the following things:

- Make sure that you have a strong password which only you (and your parents) know.
- Change your settings to make sure only trusted people can see your video and only if your parents give you consent to post it online.
- On some apps when you can post stuff like on Snapchat and Instagram make sure your location is turned off.
- Some apps/games ask you to put your location on, you NEVER EVER SHOULD PRESS ALLOW ONLY PRESS DENY!
